### **BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY OR INHIBITORS**

Hispidulin, a benzodiazepine receptor ligand with positive allosteric properties, can

traverse the blood-brain barrier and exhibit anticonvulsive effects.

Hispidulin possesses anti-inflammatory and anti-oxidative activities, it can inhibit vascular endothelial growth factor (VEGF)-induced cell migration, invasion, and capillary-like structure formation of HUVECs in a dose-dependent manner, it can suppress VEGF-induced microvessel sprouting of rat aortic rings and corneal neovascularization in C57/BL6 mice; indicates that hispidulin targets the VEGF receptor 2-mediated PI3K/Akt/mTOR signaling pathway in endothelial cells, leading to the suppression of

Hispidulin has protection on bromobenzene-induced hepatotoxicity in mice, it has inhibition of liver injury and lipid peroxidation, the hepatoprotective effects can be related

Hispidulin exerts anti-osteoporotic and bone resorption attenuating effects via activating therapeutic potential to treat diseases involving abnormal bone lysis.

Hispidulin can ameliorate high glucose-mediated endothelial dysfunction via inhibiting PKCβII-associated NLRP3 inflammasome activation and NF-κB signaling, indicates the beneficial effects of hispidulin on the improvement of endothelial dysfunction and explains its potential application in the prevention and treatment of diabetic vascular the AMPK signaling pathway in ovariectomized mice.

Hispidulin can induce mitochondrial apoptosis in acute myeloid leukemia cells by targeting complications.
